

Cupid's Cupcakes Poetry Contest Examples

The Haiku. This type of poem is comprised of three lines: first line 5 syllables, second line 7 syllables, third line 5 syllables. Here are two examples...

tastebuds aquiver
flavour, when you surround me
cupcake ecstasy

delectable cake
why do they call you a "cup"
make mine a pail-cake

The Limerick. This type of poem is five lines long, with rhyming lines in lines 1, 2 and 5, and two shorter rhyming lines in lines 3 and 4. For example....

There once was a lady named Niki
Who made cupcakes to make fingers sticky
Made with some cream
They taste like a dream
Now hurry, they're selling out quickly!
